Selection of All-Conference Teams (Revised April 2, 2013) In an effort to recognize the significant strength of the American and Liberty Divisions in sports <u>having three (3) or more divisions</u>, the follow policy (1/6/15) is:

- American Division First Team Only (Max 10) maximum 6 players and 4 open selections Honorable Mention/school (Max 2) Second Team (Max 9) has 3 open selections Honorable Mention/school (Max 2)
- Liberty Division (Max 9) maximum 6 players and 3 open selections Honorable Mention/school (Max 2)
- All other divisions (Max 9) Same positions plus 3 open selections Honorable Mention/school (Max 1)

Colonial/Independence/Freedom Divisions – If there are five (5) or fewer teams in a division, the number of awards will be the starting team number with no open positions. Honorable Mention/school (**Max 1**)

The following procedures have been approved on January 6, 2015:

- The selections are not finalized/certified until 12 Noon of the following day of the selection meeting.
- Certificates accessible via on-line.
- The SEC reserves the right to make necessary adjustments to selections.
- It is impermissible for coaches to nominate more than the sport's actual number of starting players plus one for the first and second teams The exception is: B&G Volleyball plus 2 (Approved 3/11/22)
